Dear Members,

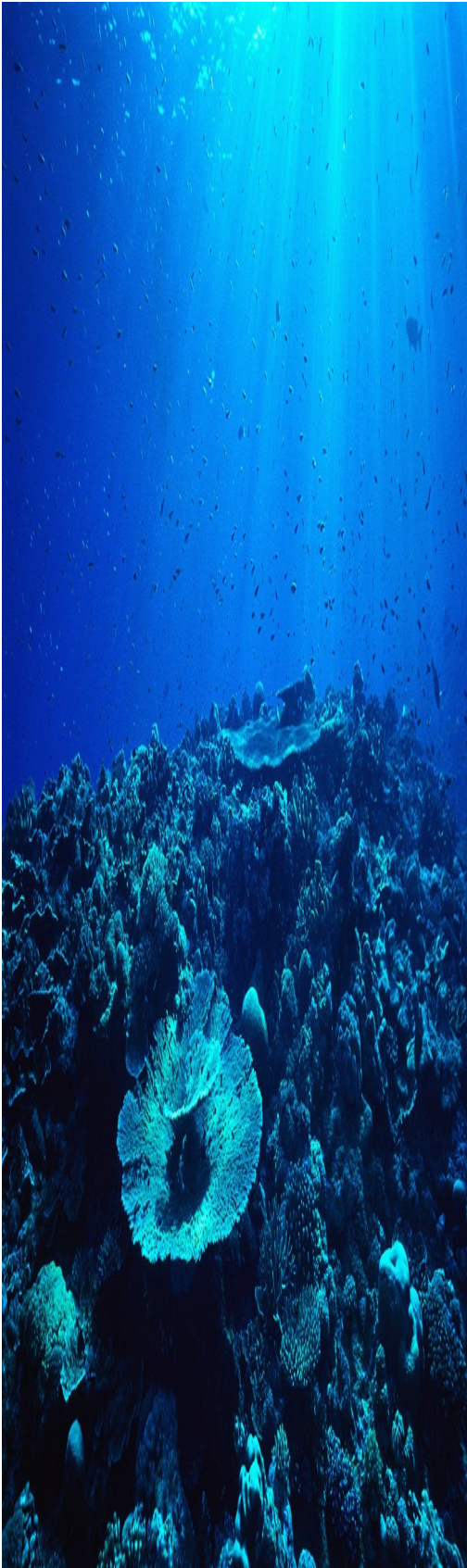
I hope everyone had a wonderful holiday season!!!
